

## Query, Watch, Results

eBatch allows users to upload a file of names to query against OffenderNet, the national near real-time offender database, and the Social Security Administration Social Security Administration Death Index File. The Death Index file is updated on a quarterly basis. Watches can also be set up against OffenderNet to provide notification if someone is arrested. If you have a list of individuals you cannot locate through other means, checking jails, Departments of Correction (DOCs), and/or the Social Security Administration Death Index File should come next.

## What Type of Data is Returned?

### - Offender information includes:

- Currently incarcerated and/or historical booking records
  - » Over 43 million records from 31 contributing states including more than 1,600 jails and 17 DOCs
- Booking facility contact information to get more details
- Last known home address, phone number, employer, and more
- Unique identifiers such as FBI number, state identification, driver's license number, and more
- Over seven million booking photos (if available)

### - Social Security Administration Social Security Administration Death Index File includes:

- Social Security Number
- First, middle, and last name
- Name suffix
- Birth and death dates
